William Shakespeare

William Shakespeare is the most famous English playwright and poet in history. He was born on 23 April 1564 in Stratford-upon-Avon. His father was a successful businessman. William had seven siblings.

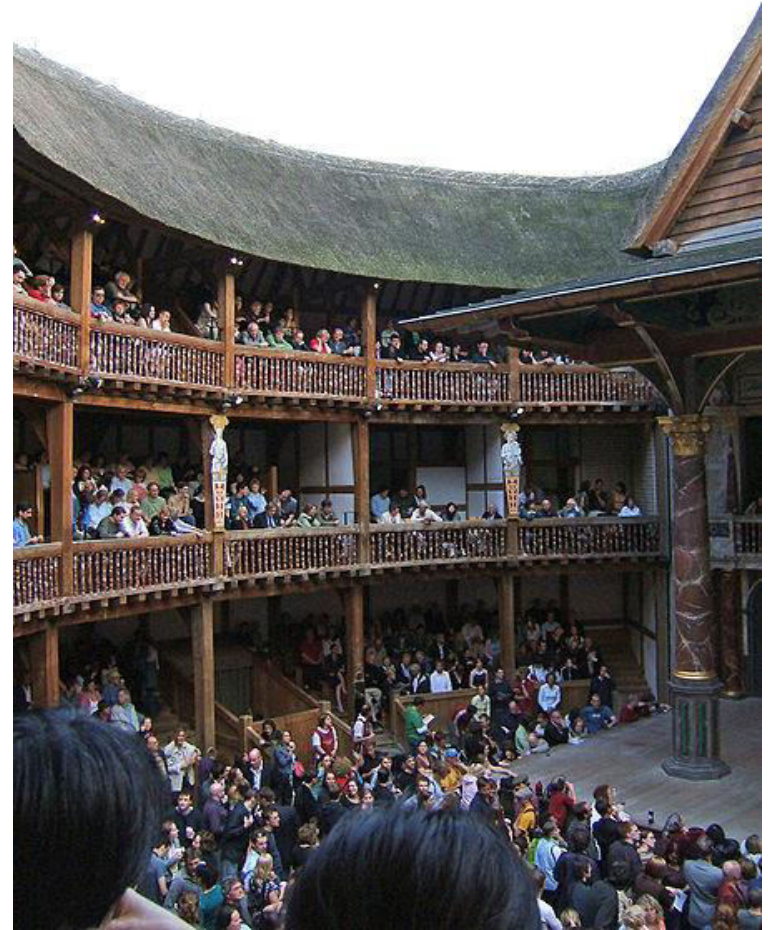
At the age of 18 he married Anne Hathaway, with whom he had three children. William left his family and began his career in London as an actor, writer, and part owner of a playing company called the Lord Chamberlain's Men, later known as the King's Men. The members of the company built their own theatre on the south bank of the river Thames, which was called the Globe.

Shakespeare produced most of his known work between 1589 and 1613. His early plays were comedies and histories, later he wrote mainly tragedies. He also wrote 154 sonnets, which were often about love, passion and death.

William moved back to Stratford 5 years before his death. He died on 23 April 1616 and was buried in the church where he had been christened 52 years earlier.
